

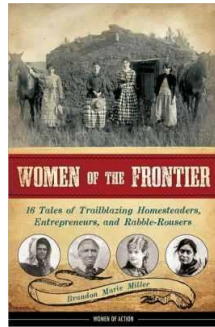
5th Grade Reading
